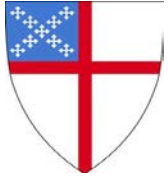

PRAYER WATCHNIGHT

As part of our commemoration of the Passion of our Lord, we will have an opportunity to do what his original disciples could not. On the night he was arrested, Jesus went to the garden to pray. He asked three of his disciples to stay awake and pray with him. They failed in that task, falling asleep not once, but three times. Finally, Jesus told them to sleep on as the armed crowd arrived to carry him off to his trial, torture, and death. In one-hour shifts, members of the Parish will hold a vigil of prayer and meditation in the Chapel of the Blessed Sacrament throughout the night, beginning after our Maundy Thursday celebration (approximately 8:00 p.m.) and continuing until the morning of Good Friday at 8:00 am. The sign-up sheet for the Maundy Thursday night vigil is in the Common Room. We would like to have someone keeping the vigil each hour. You may sign up for more than 1 hour. There are no upward limits on people keeping watch.
