Please join us for a four-hour workshop with Inclusive Communities. Focusing on issues of identity and community, workshop participants will explore techniques for examining how identity impacts our perception, experiences, and interpersonal relations in the communities we serve. We will also explore techniques for being an ally in spaces where we hold power, learning how to advocate beside individuals with marginalized identities and interrupt problematic systems. Inclusive Communities' programs are designed to examine and break down the stereotypes, myths and barriers among the divides of race, faith, gender, age and other diversities. This workshop fulfills canonical anti-racism training requirements and is open to all Nebraska Episcopalians, lay and ordained.
